EXPLANATION OF THE GAME

PUNTO BANCO

The aim of the game is to get the maximum value of nine points with at least two and not more than three cards.

Players can place bets on “Punto” (player) or “Banco” (bank), as well as on “Tie”.

If the first two cards on the Punto or Banco side total eight or nine, no further cards may be drawn.

If eight or nine is not reached, then additional cards are drawn in accordance with the game rules.



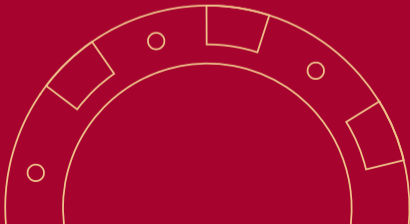


If both sides have the same number of points, the coup is undecided and the bets on “Tie” win. The bets on Punto and Banco remain in place and can be removed or changed by the players.

Cards between two and nine count for their face value. Ten, jack, queen and king count for zero. An ace counts for one.

If the total points of the two (or three) cards is a double-digit number, only the ones digit is used. E.g.: $8 + 4 = 2$

The drawing rules must be observed without exception.



DRAWING RULES

Punto	
Card total	Action
0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5	Punto is dealt a third card unless Banco has 8 or 9
6, 7	Punto is not dealt a third card
8, 9	Punto is not dealt a third card

Banco	
Card total	Action
0, 1, 2	Banco is dealt a third card unless Banco has 8 or 9
3	Banco is dealt a third card unless Punto has 8
4	Banco is dealt a third card if Punto was dealt a 2-7 as third card

Banco	
Card total	Action
5	Banco is dealt a third card if Punto was dealt a 4-7 as third card
6	Banco is dealt a third card only if Punto was dealt a 6 or 7 as third card
7	Banco is not dealt a third card
8, 9	Neither Punto nor Banco is dealt a third card



Punto Banco is played at a standard single table. Seven seated players may take part in the game. Each seated player has a box for “bank” and “player”. Standing players are permitted to play while standing only if all seated boxes are occupied. If a box is free, the player must sit down. Standing players are permitted to play on a box of the seated player as long as the box’s combined bet does not exceed the table maximum. At most one single standing player is permitted to play on the box of a seated player.

A standing player is permitted to place his/her bet only on a box of a seated player.

Bets may be placed on the “Tie” field by both seated and standing players.
